How am I doing?

- Continued professional development, food hygiene, infection control, child protection are all up to date.
- Detailed child protection policies and procedures are in place to ensure children's wellbeing.
- Anti bullying and equal opportunities policies are in place to promote fairness and protect children from discrimination.
- During the covid pandemic I undertook training in infection control specific to the coronavirus.
- Gas Boiler and appliances are inspected annually and maintained.
- Fire and heat alarms were installed in Dec 2021 to comply with new fire safety regulations.
- Risk assessments are in place for my home, and places we visit.
- Feedback from parents—parents completed a survey in January 2022 and 100% agreed that their child/ren is/are safe and protected within my setting.
- Children are relaxed, happy and at play when they are in my care. They are able to speak to me when they are experiencing difficult emotions and we work through them together.

What am I going to do now?

- Continue to monitor my CPD needs so my training as as up to date as possible.
- Identify and arrange an in-person first aid course.
- Continue my ongoing dialogue with parents about their children's needs.
- Develop a method to gather children's feedback on how safe and protected they feel with they are in my care.
